- I find prolific swearing really uncomfortable and the effect that it can have on me is I become very nervous, withdrawn and I wish that I could be in another place.
- I really struggle with crowds and it makes me feel really on edge
- My nick name in the snooker team is 'The Ambassador' I got given this by an opposing captain who said I should be an ambassador for the league as I am so polite. This about sums me up as I always want to be polite and respectful. Simone McCaskill who wrote this with me thinks I'm a real gentleman which she says are a dying species! (Her words not mine)

How can you best support me to enjoy my time at the club:

- Be patient, understanding and don't be afraid to have a chat or ask me questions about my condition to help you in understanding me better.
- I've had really negative experiences for the last 40 years of people that don't understand me mocking me which has been really hard please don't do this or stand by and watch if others do!
- My condition can be very emotionally painful for me so people being understanding and respectful of this would be helpful to me
- There are some people in the club who know me best such as Tony Coin, John Reardon, Ade Taiwo and Jack Snaylam. If you're worried about me you could always have a chat with these people on my behalf. You can also chat to Simone McCaskill the club Welfare Lead.
